# State of Rhode Island Monthly Local Hotel Report FY 2015 Local 1.0 Percent Collections May 2015

Beginning in June 2010, the Rhode Island Department of Revenue will issue a monthly report on the collection and distribution of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. The report is meant to be descriptive and does not purport to project or assess the collection of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. The report provides data by municipality on the month-to-month, year-over-year, and fiscal year-to-date-over-fiscal year-to-date collections. A discussion of the municipalities with the largest and smallest percentage and nominal changes in these three measures will be included in the body of the report.

#### **Analysis of Month-to-Month Collections**

On a statewide basis, May 2015 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$302,532 or 50.2 percent more than the \$201,477 collected in April 2015. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between May 2015 and April 2015 were: Portsmouth, 1,683.5 percent; New Shoreham, 1,527.2 percent; Narragansett, 318.0 percent; Charlestown, 204.1 percent; and Middletown, 150.8 percent. The two communities with a percentage decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between May 2015 and April 2015 were: East Greenwich, -100.0 percent; and North Smithfield, -16.3 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between May 2015 and April 2015 were: Middletown, \$23,485; Newport, \$20,289; Warwick, \$14,122; New Shoreham, \$8,687; and Westerly, \$8,656. The two communities with a nominal decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between May 2015 and April 2015: East Greenwich, \$(72); and North Smithfield, \$(19).

#### Analysis of Year-over-Year Collections by Month

On a statewide basis, May 2015 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$302,532 or 11.7 percent more than the \$270,851 collected in May 2014. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between May 2015 and May 2014 were: Portsmouth, 361.6 percent; Cranston, 65.2 percent; Middletown, 57.5 percent; Coventry, 41.8 percent; and New Shoreham, 39.8 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between May 2015 and May 2014 were: East Greenwich, -100.0 percent; Little Compton, -67.7 percent; North Smithfield, -32.6 percent; Foster, -22.8 percent; and Newport, -5.0 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between May 2015 and May 2014 were: Middletown, \$14,252; Warwick, \$4,510; Westerly, \$2,869; New Shoreham, \$2,635; and Portsmouth, \$2,035. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between May 2015 and May 2014 were: Newport, \$(2,084); East Providence, \$(101); North Smithfield, \$(48); East Greenwich, \$(26); and Little Compton \$(12).

#### Analysis of Fiscal Year-to-Date Collections through May

On a statewide basis, fiscal year-to-date May 2015 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$3.06 million or 9.0 percent more than the \$2.80 million collected in fiscal year-to-date May 2014. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date May 2015 and fiscal year-to-date May 2014 were: Portsmouth, 88.4 percent; Scituate, 42.1 percent; Johnston, 34.8 percent; Jamestown, 26.4 percent; and West Warwick, 20.9 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date May 2015 and fiscal year-to-date May 2014 were: Little Compton, -90.9 percent; East Greenwich, -24.0 percent; Glocester, -18.7 percent; Foster, -10.1 percent; and North Smithfield, -9.3 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date May 2015 and fiscal year-to-date May 2014 were: Providence, \$69,284; Middletown, \$40,593; Warwick, \$40,493; Newport, \$36,275; and Westerly, \$28,590. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date May 2015 and fiscal year-to-date May 2014 were: New Shoreham, \$(2,691); Little Compton, \$(1,638); Charlestown, \$(468); Glocester, \$(188); and North Smithfield, \$(110).
