

State of Rhode Island Monthly Local Hotel Tax Report
FY 2017 Local 1.0 Percent Collections April 2017

In June 2010, the Rhode Island Department of Revenue began issuing a monthly report on the collection and distribution of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. The report is meant to be descriptive and does not purport to project or assess the collection of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. The report provides data by municipality on the month-to-month, year-over-year, and fiscal year-to-date over fiscal year-to-date collections. A discussion of the municipalities with the largest and smallest percentage and nominal changes in these three measures will be included in the body of the report. It should be noted that late payments and adjustments generated by hotel activity in prior months may be included in this report.

Expansion of the Local Hotel Tax Base to Vacation Rentals and Hosting Platforms

Effective July 1, 2015, the reselling of lodging by online travel companies, the unlicensed rental of accommodations via internet platforms and other media, and vacation home rentals became subject to the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. For FY 2017, the hotel tax collections generated by these local hotel tax base expansion components are supposed to be distributed monthly by the Department of Revenue's Division of Taxation and the City of Newport. These figures are included in the month-to-month, year-over-year, and fiscal year-to-date over fiscal year-to-date collections for all municipalities to the extent they are available.

For FY 2016, the Division of Taxation made two distributions of the local hotel tax revenues that were generated by the expansion of the local hotel tax base. These distributions were made to all municipalities except the City of Newport. The first distribution for FY 2016 was for taxable rental activity that occurred between July 1, 2015 and December 31, 2015, inclusive. These figures are included in the analysis of fiscal year-to-date over fiscal year-to-date collections for FY 2016 for all municipalities other than the City of Newport. The second distribution was for taxable rental activity that occurred between January 1, 2016 and June 30, 2016, inclusive. These figures will be included in the analysis of fiscal year-to-date over fiscal year-to-date collections for FY 2016 for all municipalities other than the City of Newport in the June 2017 local hotel tax report. The

City of Newport began distributing the local hotel tax revenues from the base expansion on a monthly basis on July 1, 2015. These figures are included in the month-to-month, year-over-year, and fiscal year-to-date over fiscal year-to-date collections for FY 2017 and FY 2016.

The Office of Revenue Analysis (ORA) has provided a breakdown of the local hotel tax base expansion components in the local hotel tax component tables. The City of Newport did not provide a breakdown of the local hotel tax base expansion components for July through September 2016. Thus, ORA was unable to include this information in the tables, and all collections from the City of Newport that were generated by the local 1.0 percent hotel tax during that period are listed under traditional hotels. The City of Newport did provide a breakdown of the local hotel tax expansion components for October 2016 through April 2017 and those figures are included in the hosting platforms and room resellers and realtors and homeowners columns for April 2017, March 2017, and FY 2017 year-to-date as appropriate. In March 2017, the Division of Taxation distributed hotel tax collections from the local hotel tax base expansion components for taxable rental activity that occurred in October 2016 through January 2017, inclusive. In May 2017, the Division of Taxation distributed hotel tax collections from the local hotel tax base expansion components for taxable rental activity that occurred in February and March 2017. Thus, collections for March 2017 are likely overstated. In June 2017, the Division of Taxation made a similar distribution for taxable rental activity that occurred in April 2017. These figures are included in the month-to-month, year-over-year, and fiscal year-to-date over fiscal year-to-date collections for FY 2017 for all municipalities other than the City of Newport.

Analysis of Month-to-Month Collections

On a statewide basis, April 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$293,396, 5.4 percent or \$15,094 more than the \$278,302 collected for March 2017. April 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections include \$56,348 of reported collections from the expansion of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax base. This compares to \$93,336 reported for March 2017. The five communities with the largest percentage increases and decreases in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections on a month-to-month basis were:

Analysis of Year-over-Year Collections by Month

On a statewide basis, April 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$293,396, \$58,508 or 24.9 percent more than the \$234,888 collected in April 2016. April 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections include \$56,348 from the expansion of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax base in April 2017. This compares to \$9,205 reported in April 2016. The five communities with the largest percentage increases / decreases in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections for April 2017 versus April 2016 were:

Analysis of Fiscal Year-to-Date over Fiscal Year-to-Date Collections

On a statewide basis, fiscal year-to-date April 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$3.50 million, \$424,217 or 13.8 percent more than the \$3.08 million collected for fiscal year-to-date April 2016. Fiscal year-to-date April 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections include \$447,422 from the expansion of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax base. This compares to \$83,135 reported for fiscal year-to-date April 2016. The five communities with the largest percentage increases / decreases in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections for fiscal year-to-date April 2017 versus fiscal year-to-date April 2016 are listed below:
